Sonography Education Accreditation: <u>Public Review</u> of a new Allied Health Educational Program Standard

The Health Standards Organization (HSO) has drafted a new <u>CAN/HSO</u> 40001:2019 (E) Allied Health Educational Program Standard aimed at

ensuring the effectiveness of educational programs for health professions, thereby contributing to the competency of graduates and the quality of patient care in Canada. This document consists of a revision and update of the previous CMA requirements related to competency profiles, student interests and rights, education program resources (didactic personnel qualifications and experience), educational program management (oversight, administration and structure), quality improvement, and innovation. **Sonography Canada invites all active members to provide their feedback on the proposed new standard by midnight on Friday, August 9th, 2019**. How has US LI-RADS performed in HCC screening 1 year after implementation?

According to the article published in *Health Imaging Magazine* on June 5th, 2019, new research into the ACR Liver Reporting and Data System (LI-RADS) has found promising results indicating that it "emphasized sensitive and negative predictive value, key characteristics of a screening test, and that it offers a 'realistic glimpse' into the

population undergoing HCC screening in the U.S."



Midbrain area for differentiating Parkinson's disease from progressive supranuclear palsy

This article was published in Volume 183 of *Clinical Neurology and Neurosurgery* and focused on the investigation of values of midbrain area in diagnosing Parkinson's Disease (PD) and progressive supranuclear palsy (PSP) by using transcranial sonography (TCS). The

conclusion is that the "midbrain area in patients with PD was wider than those with PSP that was not affected by disease duration. Midbrain area was the most accurate index for diagnosing PD by TCS although third ventricle size was the most sensitive one for diagnosing PSP.



In an effort to help improve quality and encourage the appropriate use of ultrasound contrast, the American Society of Echocardiography established the <u>ContrastZone website</u> to

provide the cardiovascular ultrasound community with a central place on the Web to find both basic and advanced information about Ultrasound Enhancing Agents (UEA), also known as ultrasound contrast.
