

Supervisor, Echocardiography (ECG)

BC Children's Hospital, Provincial Health Services Authority

Reporting to the Program Manager, and in accordance with established policies, standards and procedures, the Echocardiography/ECG Supervisor performs the supervisory duties involved in the daily operations and activities of the Children's Heart Centre's clinical diagnostic labs including clinical supervision of technical staff in the department, instructing staff, students and physicians, and performs clinical duties as required.

In this role, you will:

- Develop and maintain policies and procedures and quality control standards for all technical aspects of the cardiac diagnostic labs (ECHO, ECG and EP) within the Children's Heart Centre, and partnership program, including ensuring the availability and maintenance of equipment in the Clinical Cardiac Diagnostic Lab areas and taking appropriate steps when there are issues.
- Participate in recruitment and interview process and provide input into selection of staff, including the interviewing and input for Physician staff, in conjunction with the Medical Director and Program Manager
- Direct, supervise and coordinate the activities of technical staff in the Children's Heart Centre by performing duties such as scheduling and coordinating work assignments, evaluating employees' performances and determining related training and orientation requirements. Reviews workload statistics as required.
- Determine staff training and development needs; develop and conduct in-service presentations and sources appropriate resources as required for staff and students. Work with provincial health authorities and Child Health BC to manage pediatric echo training requests.
- Monitor patient appointment availability; adjust appointment slots to meet demands; monitor the
 output of the Children's Heart Centre's technical labs and provide documentation of quality
 control standards.

You hold:

- Graduation from a recognized ultrasound program with adult echocardiography.
- Two (2) years recent related experience in pediatric echocardiography, or ECG plus one (1) year
 of recent supervisory experience or an equivalent combination of education, training and
 experience acceptable to the Hospital.
- Current adult and pediatric echocardiography registration with the American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers.
- Certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

You have the:

Ability to supervise others.

- Ability to adapt to working with new technology.
- Ability to operate related equipment including windows-based software packages such as word processing and the internet for clinical information.
- Demonstrated interpersonal skills including the ability to communicate effectively, verbally and in writing with all levels of staff and patients.
- Ability to deal with others effectively and function as an active member of a multidisciplinary team.
- Ability to lead and teach.
- Ability to work independently and to organize and prioritize workload
- Ability to work with children and families.
- Ability to travel to Cardiology Partnership Clinics, if required.
- Physical ability to perform the duties of the position.
