RELEVANT TO PRACTICE

- Maximum of 10 credits per triennium
- Not sonography based but must enhance professional practice.
- These activities enable the member to expand and improve their knowledge, skills and inter-professional relationships, promoting and enhancing the profession of diagnostic medical sonography and ultimately enhancing patient care.
- Relevant to practice areas include nursing, medicine, MLT, MRT, vascular and cardiac non-sonography education, management/business, educator material, veterinary sonography etc.
