<p><b>Leadership:</b> Examples include mentoring, clinical teaching, starting rounds/journal clubs</p>	<p>The nominee is excited to share their knowledge and expertise with coworkers and students, and is recognized as an excellent preceptor. They have demonstrated a high level of leadership in the field of sonography, significantly more than expected for their years of service. Five (5) or more examples have been provided.</p>	<p>The nominee enjoys sharing their knowledge and expertise with coworkers and students. They have demonstrated leadership in the field of sonography, at an appropriate level for their years of experience. Three (3) or more examples have been provided.</p>	<p>The nominee shares knowledge and expertise with coworkers and students, but only because it is mandatory. They have demonstrated some leadership in the field of sonography, but less than expected for their years of experience.</p>	<p>The nominee does not share knowledge and expertise with coworkers and students. They have not demonstrated leadership in the field of sonography or have demonstrated very little leadership.</p>	

<p><b>Personal Professional Development or Continuing Education:</b> Examples include learning a new specialty (i.e. MSK, Vascular), becoming involved in research, finishing a Bachelor's degree, starting a Master's degree</p>	<p>The nominee demonstrates an eagerness to learn and develop new skills, beyond the mandatory CME credits. The nominee has pursued additional education or training academically and/or clinically since becoming a sonographer. Three (3) or more examples have been provided</p>	<p>The nominee has met the requirements for the mandatory Sonography Canada CME Credits. They have continued to look for other ways to further their knowledge and skills to become a better sonographer. 1-2 examples have been provided.</p>	<p>The nominee has demonstrated some personal professional development or continuing education, but only to meet the mandatory Sonography Canada CME credits.</p>	<p>The nominee has not demonstrated personal professional development or continuing education.</p>	
<p><b>Involvement in the Profession:</b> Examples include volunteering on a provincial or national committee, speaking at conferences, changing clinical practice, publishing articles in the Canadian Journal of Medical Sonography</p>	<p>The nominee is an advocate for the profession. They are very involved in the profession and are always looking for new ways to become more involved, above and beyond expectations for their level of experience. Five (5) or more examples have been provided.</p>	<p>The nominee has become moderately involved in the profession. They are interested in helping out whenever possible and are active members of their committees. Three (3) or more examples have been provided.</p>	<p>The nominee has minimal involvement in the profession. They will meet their responsibilities but are not interested in going above and beyond expectations.
