

Don't Forget to Award CPD Credit to Your Presenters/Speakers!

Your CPD Activity Approval means that you will issue Sonography Based or Relevant to Practice *Directed* CPD Credits to participants, as well as speakers/presenters. CPD Credit for speakers may only be relevant for Sonographers and Technologists. For Sonography Canada members, the following is a guide of how many credits can be claimed under Educational Services:

When a sonographer prepares and delivers a lecture for your educational rounds, webinars, conferences, lectures, workshops approved by Sonography Canada, you may issue a certificate of participation:

- Presenters of CPD activities can earn a maximum of 8 CPD Credits (SB or RP) for the preparation and delivery of a 50–60-minute lecture/presentation.
- The 8-credit maximum can be pro-rated:
 - 4 credits for a 30-minute presentation
 - 4 credits each if there are two speakers sharing a 1-hour session
- As CPD Provider, **you** issue a certificate to the speaker. Include the date, the approved activity, and the number and type of credits. The speaker then uploads the certificate to their CPD Tracker.
- A great incentive for sonographers to get involved in presenting their work and knowledge.
